RE: Unauthorized use of State Trust Land

Dear Toby:

The Colorado Board of Land Commissioners ("Board" or "State Land Board") acknowledges that Eagle County Open Space is currently discussing leasing options on the "Arrowhead" parcel with State Land Board staff, including a possible option to acquire the property at a future date. Until such a lease is formalized and/or an acquisition is complete, we respectfully request that all materials indicating or promoting public recreational opportunities on or across the Arrowhead property (e.g. A-10 Loop Trail) be removed from public websites, newsletters, maps, etc.

As a reminder, public use of the Arrowhead parcel (Township 5 South, Range 82 West, Section 16), is not authorized by the Colorado State Board of Land Commissioners and is considered trespass per state statutes (C.R.S. §36-1-121). The State Land Board intends to post this property with "No Trespassing" signs this summer.
