



STAGE 2 - FIRE RESTRICTIONS



What is NOT ALLOWED?

Fireworks sales, use & possession. ALL personal uses of Fireworks are prohibited.



Building, maintaining, attending or using an open fire, campfire or open flame outdoors is PROHIBITED. This includes charcoal grills, BBQs, coal and wood burning stoves in developed camping or picnic grounds.



Smoking outdoors when not in a developed recreational site or in an area that is cleared of all combustible materials.



Shooting or discharge of firearms for recreational purposes on private or public land. No explosive targets or incendiary (tracer) rounds. These are never allowed on Federal lands.



Using any internal or external combustion engine (chainsaw, ATV, generator etc.) WITHOUT a spark-arresting device.



Welding or operating acetylene or other torch device with open flame outdoors. A 'hotwork' permit can be issued thru a local fire department with site inspection.



What IS ALLOWED?

Professional fireworks displays are allowed.



Fires contained within liquid fueled or gas fueled stoves, lanterns, or heating devices on PUBLIC or PRIVATE land with a shut off valve.



Smoking within an enclosed vehicle, building, developed recreation site, or in an area that is cleared of all combustible materials.



Shooting or discharging firearms for **hunting**, with a valid and current hunting license on private or public lands.



Using internal or external combustion engines WITH a spark-arresting device, and a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher and a sound pointed shovel at least 35" long and readily available for use.
